SUCCESSFUL IMPLEMENTATIONS AT NELSON MANDELA & FORT HARE UNIVERSITIES

Our Intellimali Activation Team visited Nelson Mandela University (NMU) in Gqeberha and Fort Hare University (UFH) in East London during February and March.

Thousands of students attended presentation sessions where they received their Intellicard and were advised about the merchants from which they can purchase goods and services. Students were also introduced to our App – IntelliCell – and reminded of the Call Centre and technical support services we have on offer to assist them.



SUCCESSFUL REGISTRATION AT UNIVERSITY OF STELLENBOSCH

Our Activation Team also paid a visit to Stellenbosch University, during which they were able to educate students about the Intellimali system. They issued Intellicards, registered students who are entitled to a food allowance, explained the power of the IntelliCel App and provided much needed additional support.





ENHANCING THE PAYMENT EXPERIENCE

Our technical teams have been hard at work visiting merchants at key locations. We have increased the options available to facilitate and enhance the payment service significantly for 2022.

Students can use both the Intellicard or the IntelliCell App to initiate a payment while merchants can offer the traditional 'POS' (Point-of-sale) device, IntelliPos or the new IntelliScan solution.

In all cases, payments are processed quickly and recorded in real-time producing records for both merchant and student.
